GENERAL SUMMARY OF DUTIES: Radiologic Technologist makes an assessment as to what x-rays should be taken prior to the office visit. Proper techniques must be used to obtain quality films for diagnostic purposes. Assist the Clinical Staff as needed.

ENVIRONMENTAL/WORKING CONDITIONS

Work is performed in a medical practice environment. Involves frequent contact with staff and the public. Work may be stressful at times. Contact may involve dealing with angry or upset people. Exposure to bodily fluids is possible.

PHYSICAL/MENTAL DEMANDS

Work requires dexterity for walking, stooping, bending and lifting, mobility to assist patients, or standing and walking for extended periods of time. Requires ability to move equipment and transfer patients. Must possess visual and auditory acuity in order to communicate with physicians, co-workers, patients and other customer groups. Possible exposure to chemical hazards, but is not limited to toxic hazardous substances, film processing solutions and disinfectants. Possible exposure to communicable diseases and body fluids. Must be able to lift patients.
